As you know, cigarette smoking harms nearly every organ of the body, causes many diseases, reduces health in general, and is a particularly serious issue for persons with serious and persistent mental illness and/or substance use disorders. Pennsylvania has set out to implement a statewide comprehensive tobacco-use prevention program. Each PH-MCO and BH-MCO has also developed work plans to assist in this statewide effort. State-level initiatives include a telephone quitline, efforts to counter tobacco marketing, surveillance of tobacco sales to minors, and assessment and treatment of tobacco addiction.
