The RED toolkit was originally developed by the Boston University Medical Center with support from the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ), and this approach can be used with any population. Although RED was originally designed for physical health/medical hospitals, it can be successfully adapted for use by Mental Health Inpatient Hospital providers.
