Subject: AD 23-103 Telehealth Using Site Based Clinic Model

OMHSAS-Telehealth Bulletin 22-02 allows for telehealth services in home and community settings, however PerformCare also allows Mental Health and Substance Use Outpatient providers to provide site-based telehealth for members seen in the office setting when the practitioner is in a remote location performing services via telehealth. When services are delivered with the provider office as the originating site, PerformCare will pay an enhanced rate to cover the cost of face-to-face contact in the office to assist in facilitating the telehealth visit. Providers must comply with OMHSAS Telehealth Bulletin 22-02 and offer a clinically appropriate mix of face-to-face services, telehealth when the member is in their own home and may utilize site-based telehealth per the conditions of this notice.

If a provider who was not already approved for the site-based model of telehealth under either OMHSAS telehealth Bulletin 11-09, 14-01, or 20-02 is interested in billing with this model, they should submit a service description to PerformCare addressing all the areas outlined in the Service Description Template attached. While OMHSAS Bulletin 11-09, 14-01, and 20-02 are all obsolete with the issuance of OMHSAS Telehealth 22-02, the obsolete bulletins describe the required elements for the enhanced rate.

Providers approved by PerformCare for site-based telehealth should use the GT modifier for billing telehealth visits (using audio and video transmission) for psychiatry and medication management visits when the originating site is at a clinic. The originating site must have staff trained and available to provide clinical intervention in person if a need arises per OMHSAS 22-02. The GT modifier is eligible for MH OP clinics (08/110), SU OP Clinics (08/184) CRNP (09/103), Psychiatry (31/339) and is allowable for the following base procedure codes:

Site Based Telepsychiatry Service Description Template

Service Description elements should include the following components:

- 1. Provider Detail information (include detail for each clinic site).
 - Provider name
 - Provider type (08/110, 08/184, 09/103, 31/339)
 - License number
 - Promise number
 - Provider address (site)
- 2. Describe the locations that will be connected:
 - Practitioner Site:
 - Originating site (member location):
- 3. Describe the HIPAA compliant equipment/technology that will be used for telehealth (OMHSAS 21-09).
- 4. Describe how the service will be provided, outlining the individual's experience through the process.
 - This section should explain the individual's experience receiving the service to include scheduling, education and consent to telehealth, etc.
- 5. Describe the minimum qualifications of the staff that will be available at the individual site to support the individual through the telehealth appointment.
 - Include the job title and qualifications of anyone assisting the individual throughout the telehealth appointment (before, during, and after physician appointment) and duties of each
- 6. Describe how the staff at the individual's site of services will assist and communicate with the practitioners and individuals, including how staff will be summoned by a practitioner or individual if needed.
 - Describe how any screening/assessments, vitals, etc. will be communicated to the physician/prescriber performing telepsychiatry.
- 7. Describe how prescriptions or orders for medication will be managed, as well as orders for other services.
 - If this will be done via Electronic Health Record (EHR) then describe the process
- 8. Describe how and where the medical record will be maintained (Paper vs Electronic).
 - If an electronic health record is used, will the prescriber have direct access to the medical record at the practitioner site?

- 9. Attach Provider Policies (OMHSAS 22-02)
 - Written policy for the operation and use of telehealth equipment.
 - Written policy regarding contingency plan for transmission failure or other technical difficulties.
 - Written policy for determining appropriateness for telehealth delivery of services
 - Patient education information regarding telehealth including:
 - o Telehealth consent and options to be seen in person or outside of clinic (if offered)
 - o the amount of caregiver involvement needed when services provided to child, youth, or young adult
