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In an effort to continue sharing Trauma Informed Care resources with our provider network, PerformCare would like to reference the online resource of The National Child Traumatic Stress Network (NCTSN) <https://www.nctsn.org/> NCTSN offers a wide array of free e-learning resources and continuing education trainings which may be searched by audience (e.g. families/caregivers, child welfare professionals, school personnel, youth, etc). Trainings may be accessed by clicking on *Resources* then *Training*, scrolling down to Online Training, and creating a free account online following the registration link. Registration will provide access to the NCTSN Learning Center.

Trainings and e-learning resources offered through the NCTSN Learning Center cover a wide range of Trauma Informed Care topics relevant to children, families and child serving systems (e.g. Childhood Traumatic Grief; Partnering with Youth and Families in Trauma Settings; Creating Trauma Informed Care Systems). Trainings relevant to special populations are also available (e.g. Homeless Youth, Adolescent Trauma and Substance Abuse; Trauma and Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD); Military Families).

Most trainings are 1 hour and 30 minutes in length. Continuing education credits are available for many of the webinars and courses through NBCC, APA and/or NASW **with exceptions**. For information regarding CEU's please visit:
