

## Provider Notice

**To:** All PerformCare FQHC Providers

**Subject:** AD 25 112 FQHC TRR Documentation Requirements

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This Provider Notice serves as a reminder to FQHC Providers of the expectations for documentation and parameters for PerformCare Treatment Record Reviews (TRR).

- A Treatment 'episode of care' should have a clear 'start date' (initiation of service) and clear 'end date' (close of service), with reason for termination of that 'episode of care'. If a Member needs to be seen again following a completed 'episode of care' a 'new' start date for that 'episode of care' should be initiated.
- Members being seen regularly within an episode of care, beyond <sup>1</sup>brief intervention, should have an active and individualized treatment plan, an active and individualized crisis/safety plan (if applicable), and evidenced based assessment and outcome tools within their records. Please reference PerformCare Provider Manual, Chapter VII *Provider Responsibilities* (page 40) and Chapter XI *Covered Services and Authorization Requirements* (page 90).
- Effective 7/1/25, for Treatment Record Review (TRR) purposes, the PerformCare Quality Management Department will only request records of Members that are being seen regularly within an episode of care, beyond brief intervention.
  - Records selected for review by PerformCare, should have an individualized treatment plan, individualized crisis/safety plan (if applicable), and evidenced based assessment and outcome tools included.

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<sup>1</sup> Brief therapy/intervention is often shorter than traditional therapy in both session time and number of sessions. For example, brief intervention, during an episode of care, might include 4-6 sessions with sessions lasting approximately 20-30 mins.
