Effective 7/1/25, providers with the 08/184 type and specialty can bill PerformCare for Interprofessional consultation services performed by a physician **via the 99452**. Eligible providers can bill PerformCare for consultation services described below that meet the CMS standard for consultation without the Member present as well as the required verbal reporting and written reports as applicable that must be submitted by the consulting professional to the treating practitioner. The MA bulletin includes these descriptions but additional guidance for these codes is found below. The rates for these services are listed in Attachment A.
