- **Policy:** To provide FBMH and TCM providers with a mechanism to request to continue TCM during FBMH Services.
- **Purpose:** To determine the use of FBMH Services concurrently TCM.
- **Definitions: TCM:** Targeted case management including Intensive Case Management (ICM), Resource Coordination (RC) and Blended Case Management (BCM) where available.
- Acronyms: FBMHS: Family Based Mental Health Services IP: Identified Person
- **Procedure:** 1. FBMHS regulations require that FBMHS teams provide case management and crisis intervention functions 24 hour a day, 7 days-a-week.
 - 2. Because of this requirement, TCM services would be warranted to only families with complex behavioral health needs.
 - 3. At the initiation of FBMHS, TCM services that are currently approved for the IP will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
 - 4. Siblings of the IP who are involved with TCM services will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
 - 5. The FBMHS treatment plan and the TCM services plan will indicate how the providers will work together and reflect the goals of each service during FBMHS delivery. The goals of each service must be identified and may not be duplicative.

	6. All routinely required documentation must be submitted to the PerformCare CCM for requesting initial and reauthorization for TCM services. The TCM provider will be responsible for the submission.
