Subject: SU 25 104 Adding SU Residential LOCs to PerformCare's Network

For In-Network Substance Use (SU) Residential providers that wish to add additional programs to our network, providers must complete an in-plan application as well as a service description. Specifically, PerformCare is noticing providers that are adding the following levels of care to their programs not following the above process:

1. Providers currently in-network for 3.5 level of care who want to add 3.7 level of care
2. Providers currently in-network for 3.5 level of care who have become Co-Occurring Enhanced
3. Providers currently in-network for 3.7 level of care who have become Co-Occurring Enhanced

As a reminder, providers must be dually licensed by DDAP and OMHSAS and have a rate issued by the provider's home county SCA before the Co-Occurring Enhanced designation can be added to PerformCare's system. Clinical requirements for these programs is outlined in [SU 23 102 SUD Co-Occurring Enhanced Requirements](#).

Providers are reminded to notify PerformCare if the level of care that your program offers changes. Specifically, providers must notify PerformCare if your program changes to co-occurring enhanced or if your program no longer offers co-occurring enhanced. These program changes must be communicated to your Account Executive.
